

## **DO-OVER ABNORMAL TOURNAMENT RULES**

1. The home team will be decided by a coin flip. The winner of the flip will have the choice of the “home team” and bat last, or the “visitor team” and start the game with a ½ run. There are no extra inning games.
2. **FIRST INNING ONLY** - The batter will receive one pitch. If it is called a ball, the batter walks to first base. If it is a strike, the batter must hit the ball fair - a foul ball or a called strike and the batter is out.
3. **THIRD INNING ONLY** - The four outfielders will play 4 of the 6 infield positions. Four infielders must play the outfield positions. All players must have played the second inning.
4. **FIFTH INNING ONLY** – All batters that bat will run the bases in reverse order. The runner will be thrown out at third instead of first.
5. During the game, each team is entitled to one offensive and one defensive “DO-OVER”. In other words, if the team does not like the outcome of a certain play, they have 45 seconds to decide if they want to do the play over. If that is the case, all runners return to their original bases and the batter bats with a 0-0 count.
6. The last batter in the line-up will be given a visible means of identification to wear. Each time that batter is able to score, it will count for three runs. It might be a good time for a “DO-OVER”!
7. Normal/Standard uniforms are not required. You are allowed (encouraged) to wear costumes or themed matching attire. Anything worn **MUST BE** family friendly and not sexually explicit. Anything deemed inappropriate by tournament staff could lead to an out or ejection of an individual or team.

## **NORMAL TOURNAMENT RULES**

1. All divisions will play a double elimination / consolation tournament. Any division with 24 or more teams will use a (2-0, 1W-1L, 1L-1W, 0-1) bracket system.
2. Each team will furnish a playable ball for each game (For Men’s and Women’s Tournament). Each team will hit its own ball. **Yellow softball .52 core and 300 compression requirement.**
3. 20-man roster with maximum of 5 pick-ups.
4. Rosters due before the first game.
5. Umpire’s decision is final – no protests.
6. In case of rain, the tournament director reserves the right to change the format, i.e., dropping of a loser’s bracket, change times and/or fields. Every effort will be made to play the tournament as set.
7. Basher’s, the management, or tournament director is not responsible for any accidents or injuries in connection with the tournament.
8. **ENTRIES ARE DUE BY: 6/25/2019 for Men’s.** Division will be filled on a first come, first paid basis.

**TEAMS ARE NOT IN THE TOURNAMENT UNTIL THE ENTRY FEE IS PAID.**
